Scripps Howard Communications Internship Teen Mental Wellness and Suicide Prevention

Description:

Seeking a Scripps Howard Communications Intern to work 10-15 hours per week supporting our organization with marketing and communications activities including the launch of Hope Squads throughout Ohio and Northern Kentucky.

Grant Us Hope's mission is to provide mental wellness, trauma, suicide prevention and school safety services. This is accomplished through consulting activities with school districts as well as the implementation of Hope Squads in area schools. Hope Squad is a peer-to-peer, evidenced-based program that trains students to be the eyes and ears of the school. By doing so, the intent is to create a cadre of students who are good listeners, know and understand the warning signs of suicide, and the strategies of Question, Persuade and Refer (QPR) to connect the peer in crisis to intervention services. Grant Us Hope is currently establishing Hope Squads in over 35 schools in Ohio. We anticipate significant growth in 2019 to include more schools in Ohio as well as Northern Kentucky.

Details:

- Intern must be in his/her junior or senior year at the University of Cincinnati, Xavier University or Northern Kentucky University majoring in communications, marketing and/or public relations
- Internship runs January 1-May 30, 2019
- 10-15 hours per week (includes approximately 5-6 hours in our office each week)
- \$10/hour

Specific Skills:

- Collaborate with GUH staff to understand goals, priorities, target audiences, key messaging, desired outcomes, delivery vehicles and measurable results
- Communicate with external and internal stakeholders (both verbal and written)
- Implement social media strategies, tactics, execution and measurement
- Assist with the production of print materials to support programs and events
- Compile, discern, and filter research on critical resources, reliable data points and best practices within the scope of suicide prevention, mental health wellness and teen empowerment
- Refresh website content as needed (WordPress)
- Manage and maintain Twitter, Instagram, and Facebook accounts
- Support day-to-day organizational activities
- Serve as an ambassador for Grant Us Hope and our mission within the community
